

Lets Get Physical With Tesco

We are delighted to let you know that our application to the Tesco Bags of Help Grant Scheme has been successful and our project will be put forward to a customer vote in Tesco stores during March and April 2018 using the blue token scheme. The proposed project would help us to develop our outside area to provide the children with access to an exciting new climbing apparatus. The equipment will help develop all areas of their development, from the obvious physical climbing of the apparatus (including children with disabilities) to mathematics, counting their steps and communication and language as they discuss their experiences.

The equipment will support the families in our community, encouraging and providing opportunities for the children to stay healthy and continue to make good progress within all areas of learning. By providing the children with a good start within education, we will be preparing them for transitioning into local schools which will also benefit our local community.

What happens next?

Our project along with the other two projects in our region will go forward to a vote in Tesco stores where customers will decide the outcome by voting for their favourite project each time they shop. Voting will take place from **Thursday 1st March to Monday 30th April 2018** and we will know by the end of May 2018 if we have been successful.

The project with the highest number of votes across our region will receive £4,000 (or the amount that was requested up to this value), the second placed project £2,000 (or the amount that was requested up to this value), and the third placed project £1,000.
